



**Paul Benn** graduated in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Sheffield, in 1992. His clinical career in HIV medicine spans over 20 years. He trained in Genito-urinary medicine at the Mortimer Market Centre and University College London where he was appointed Consultant and Honorary Senior Lecturer in 2004. Between 2010 and 2014 he acted as the Clinical Lead for the HIV service. His research interests include antiretroviral therapy, toxicities, HIV pre- and post exposure prophylaxis and the sexual health of men who have sex with men. He was a member of several national special interest groups and guideline committees and has 26 publications in peer reviewed journals including the Lancet. He joined the pharmaceutical industry in 2014 and now works for ViiV Healthcare as the European Medical Lead for Cabotegravir.
